## CORRESPONDANCE:

**Rental Agreement:** The McIntyre Curling Club new rental agreement with the City of Timmins will increase by 2% again this season. Our rent for the 2016/17 season is \$16,074

**New Sign:** the new McIntyre Curling Club sign has been installed above the club entrance. Check it out. Looks great. New Horizons committed to invest up to 50% of the cost.

**Ice Maker Training:** Dave Moore will be the new Ice Maker for the Club. The club is looking for someone interested in the assistant Ice Maker position.

## NEW BUSINESS:

2016/17 FEE STRUCTURE: regular event fees will remain unchanged from last season:

League Membership: \$50.00 (includes \$15 NOCA fee, which is unchanged from last season but is subject to change)

Regular Curling Fee: \$5.00 per game on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday:

Special Events Fees: Challenge Round, Dusty Baker, Joe Gubbells, etc. entry fees are set separately to cover costs.

2016/17 DRAW STRUCTURE: will remain unchanged

**Free Guard Zone rule is in effect for ALL games and events.**

1. Tuesday & Thursday draws at 0900 and 1030 weekly unless announced otherwise.
  - 6 ends of play

*ACTION:* we require volunteers to help organize these two draws

#### PRE- GAME PROCEDURE

- members are advised that if they have not paid their fee and have their name on the player list at least 20 minutes before game time, they may not get to play their position according to seniority
- player position lists will pulled together 15 minutes before the start time of each draw.
- the seniority list to be followed as much as possible
- announcements and team selection to start at least 10 minutes before game time.
- draw master needs to speak loudly and slowly. People are moving around as they draw their number and move to the ice. Some people have difficulty hearing.
- players need to ensure they are quiet and listening for their name to be called and to remember what ice they draw.

2. Wednesday League start at 0900.

- sign up as teams
- two draws Pre-Christmas and Post-Christmas
- 8 ends of play. Rules to be posted

#### **CURLING EVENTS:**

Sign up sheets will be posted at ice level for all special event such as the Dusty Baker, the Joe Gubbells, the Challenge Rounds etc

Teams for these events will be determined from the sign up sheet by a Draw Committee consisting of Noel Arbic, Rita Beaudry, Gervais Pelletier and assisted by Ray Ginglo. The Committee will set the schedule.

Check the Bulletin Board at ice level for Team lists, schedules, sign up sheets and other updates, club news or general information.

**REGISTRATION:** will be held Oct 12 and 13 from 900 to 1200 hr

An Introduction to Curling will be offered each day between 0930 until 1130

Anyone interested in trying out the game is most welcome. Clean shoes are required.

Ice should also be available for practice during registration.
